

WORSHIP & SPIRITUALITY

- Include youth (elementary school age) choir at one weekend Mass a month.
- Review Sunday schedule for possible education opportunities for both youth and adults (e.g., making use of the new parish center between Masses).
- Look for, or create, a program for families or small groups to develop deeper habits of prayer.
- Develop a study and reflection plan so that the sacramental life of the church is more deeply understood and more fully experienced at all age levels.
- Improve advertising about Reconciliation Services.

YOUTH & YOUNG ADULT MINISTRIES

- Broader involvement of youth participation in all of the liturgical ministries.
- Educate our youth about their Catholic faith relating to current moral, social and religious issues and teach them to defend their Catholic faith.
- Further develop the Young Adult Ministry.
- Coordinate with other Youth and Young Adult Ministers in the dioceses and institute best practices.
- Expose our youth to a variety of outreach and evangelizing opportunities.
- Expand the youth ministry program through mission trips, retreats and conferences.
