### **End of Year Church Contributions Statement**

1. Any contribution check which is brought to the church or placed in the collection **must be received in the parish office by Dec 31, 2017**, in order for it to be put on your 2017 contribution statement from the church. Even if the check is dated for December but **arrives in January's collection it will be too late for the 2017 contribution statement** and will be count towards 2018 church contributions.

2. A contribution check which is **mailed to the church and is post-marked by Dec. 31, 2017** will be counted as part of your 2017 contribution statement from the church, even though the church might received it after Dec 31, 2017.
